MITCHELL DEJONG BATTLES FOR THE WIN AT CORR ROUND 5

Temecula, CA (June 18, 2008) Race fans filled the stands at the LA Fairplex in Pomona, CA as round 5 of Championship Off Road Racing (CORR) kicked off. CORR had some surprises for the racers and the fans as they reconstructed the track and changed the driving direction from the previous Pomona race. These changes were welcomed by 10 year old, Mitchell DeJong, pilot of the DeJong Off Road Elite Truck. The only thing on his mind was to take home a podium finish.

Prior to qualifying, Mitchell's crew chief and father, Vince DeJong, spent hours making final preparations on Mitchell's truck with the help of his Makita Power Tools. With the FOX RACING SHOX tested and tuned, Mitchell blistered the field and qualified 2nd in his new 250cc Amsoil lubricated Honda powered Elite Kart.

As the Saturday main event drew a record 26 Modified Karts, Mitchell knew that he needed to keep focused and his "eyes on the prize." As the green flag dropped, Mitchell immediately battled the #500 reigning Modified Kart Champ, Parker Grabowski for the lead. Successfully making their way through lap traffic, Mitchell's Douglas Wheels gripped hard and he was able to make a move in Lap 5 for the pass.

The crowd was going wild watching these 2 trucks battle each other as they passed the entire field of lap traffic. A fan said, "That Mitchell is a force to be reckoned with, he's an awesome driver."

The checkered flag was in sight and Mitchell was within 50 yards from his first CORR Modified Kart win, until lap traffic turned into Mitchell sending him towards the k-rail. The #500 truck was able to take advantage of the situation and make the pass. With some quick maneuvering, Mitchell pushed hard crossing the line in a photo-finish for the top-spot, but officials ruled that Mitchell took 2nd place. Although the win would have been much sweeter, Mitchell DeJong proves once again that he can run at the top of the class, and he now holds a top-10 points standing going into Rounds 7&8 on July 26-27, 2008 in San Diego, CA.
