

CLEAN SWEEP FOR ZIMMER IN CANADA

New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island, Canada-Jon Zimmer and John Killinger made their trip to Canada worthwhile, completing a weekend sweep of competition at two venues in two nights this past weekend.
