### ***Boron, Morin split Pro finals in Windham for Rock Maple Racing snocross series***

WINDHAM, NY (April 6, 2009) — Multi-time champion Jason Boron and Quebec veteran Mathieu Morin split the Pro finals on Sunday afternoon, as Rock Maple Racing (RMR) completed the final Central series snocross event of the 2008-09 season at the Windham Mountain ski resort.

Boron, of Leverett, MA, piloted his **Outdoor Performance/D&Z Racing Ski-doo** to victory in Pro Open, with John O'Malley second and Kenny Murphy third. Other than Jason's brother Matt (Malone, NY) and Jason Stone (Barton, VT), O'Malley (Verona, NY) was the only other rider besides Danny Poirier to post a win all season.

Morin (**XP-S Ski-doo**), of Val D'or, Quebec, earned a rare RMR Pro victory with a convincing performance in Pro Stock. Morin, who recently concluded his season for Warnert Racing on the ISOC national circuit, held off Boron and Renaud Alexandre for top honors.

Defending Pro Vet champion Joe Lemieux (**Ski-doo**) scored another final round win over Joel Santy and Rene Desrochers. Lemieux, of St. Johnsbury, VT, was on top of his game with fast and consistent runs all season. Joe's niece Michelle also capped a strong 2009 effort with a win Sunday, holding off Janell Smith and cousin Steffanie Lemieux in the Pro Women final.

In Semi-Pro action Sunday, **Aaron Pfeifer** and **Jake Melville** both recorded final round wins. Pfeifer, of Blossvale, NY, converted the momentum built from his victory in the Shootout at Findley Lake into a win in Stock 600. Pfeifer out-gunned fellow New York rider Cory Ostrander and Melville to earn the win. Melville, of Pownal, VT, helped his chances in the final point standings with his win in Semi-Pro Open. Pfeifer finished a close second, while Nick Kelley came home third.

In Sport division action at Windham, Joey Mosher and Joey Stock each registered wins. Mosher, of Salem, NH, rode his **Team Explosive Ski-doo** to victory in Saturday's Super Stock final, with Stock second and Travis Brisbin third. Stock, of Bearsville, NY, claimed Sunday's Super Stock final over Simon Taillefer and Dylan Bisson. Stock also claimed the Sport Stock 600 final over Chris Ingles and Brisbin on Sunday.

Will Fletcher (16-17 Stock 600 Fan) and Whitney Covill (16-17 Stock 500) led a long list of winners in Junior division action in Windham. Jake Scott, who unofficially locked up the Junior division championship Sunday, won the 14-15 Stock 600 Fan final over Nick Zielinski and Trevor Boutin. Maine-based rider Nick St. Amand rode his Arctic Cat to victory in the 14-15 Stock 500 final, with Scott second and Boutin third. Other Junior division winners include Leo Patenaude (10-13 Stock 380 Fan) and Hunter Sherwood (8-10 300 Freestyle Saturday & Sunday).

Other final round winners in Central series action over the weekend in Windham include Kory Bouthillier (Sport 500); Joe Klimas (Sport Stock 600 Fan); Joel Santy (Plus 35 Masters); Christian Ellsworth (Plus 25 Stock); Amanda Kirchmeyer (Women Stock 600 Sat.); Steffanie Lemieux (Women Stock 600 Sun.); Sarah Acker (Women Stock Novice & Jr. Girls 10-13 Stock 600 Fan); and Ian Liebmann (Trail 600 Saturday).

Some of RMR's West series teams also concluded their 2008-09 season in Windham over the weekend. Riders in the Sport and Junior divisions took center stage, with several young athletes rising to the occasion.

Simon Taillefer piloted his Ski-doo to victory in Saturday's Sport Super Stock final, while Nathan Leclaire claimed Sunday's battle. Michael Sickler made the long haul from Harvey's Lake, PA, worthwhile with his win in Sport 500. Ryan Jabs completes our list of Sport division winners after out-dueling Leclaire and Trevor Day in Stock 600.
